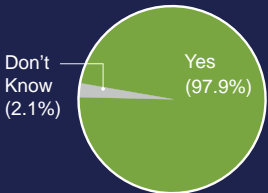
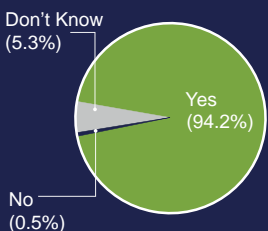


OUTCOME OF OUR FIRST PUBLIC DISCUSSION

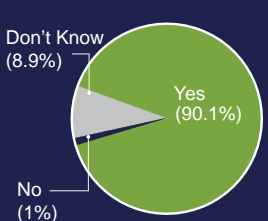
97.9% of respondents were supportive of the principle of a renewable energy generation
