

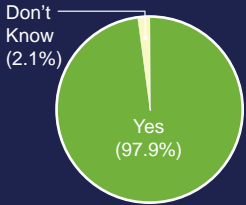

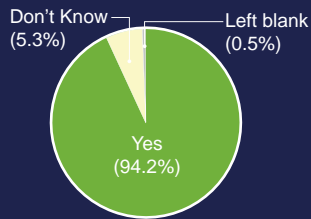


Location of proposed Renewable Energy Plant in Rosyth

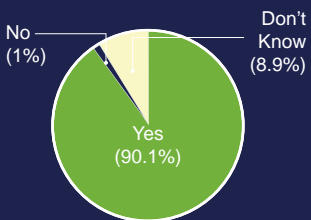
98% of respondents were supportive of the principle of a renewable energy generation

- **Visual impact**

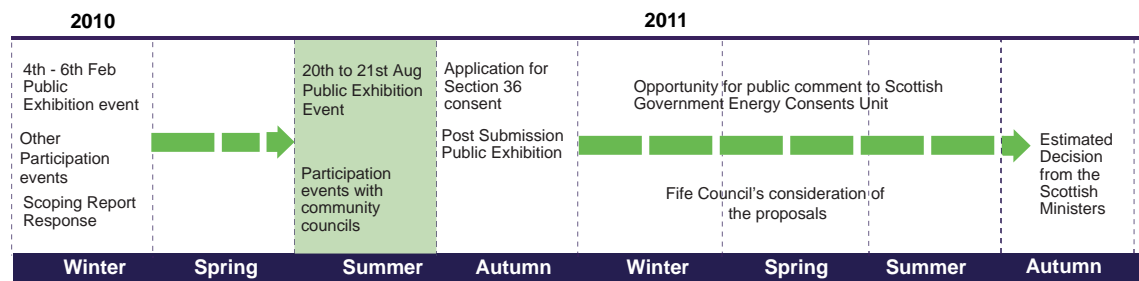
The project team will be available at the exhibition and there will be an opportunity to make comments.
