

Forth Energy Rosyth Renewable Energy Plant

You are invited to attend a public exhibition in Rosyth on 20th and 21st August to view information on proposals for a Biomass Renewable Energy Plant at the Port of Rosyth.

The exhibition is the second in a series of public exhibitions that Forth Energy is undertaking to:

Answer the questions asked when we introduced the proposals in February; and

Enable local residents to find out more about the project and contribute their views.

Forth Energy's proposals would enable the generation of low carbon, renewable electricity, sufficient to power 160,000 homes, meeting the needs of 42% of the Fife area. This will make Rosyth an important part of achieving ambitious carbon reduction targets set out by the Scottish Government in the recent Climate Change (Scotland) Act.

Members of the project team will be available at the exhibition to discuss the proposals.
